



Economy of Regions announces a call for papers for an upcoming Special Issue “Economy of the Arctic and Northern Regions” Vol. 21, Is. 2, June 2024

The Arctic and Northern regions are the most dynamically developing, promising and interesting territories for interdisciplinary research. Despite the complicated geopolitical situation, the issues of exploration and development of the Arctic remain relevant both in Russia and the world. The strategic plans of various countries for the development of the Arctic involve international cooperation in different areas of economic activity. Global climate change can create both risks and opportunities for the Arctic and Northern regions. To implement plans for regional development, it is necessary to establish an infrastructure and solve socio-demographic problems. **Economy of Regions** invites authors to submit manuscripts to the special issue “Economy of the Arctic and Northern Regions”.

The main scope is:

- Problems of modern economic and social development of Russian and Global Arctic and Northern regions
- Limitations and opportunities for current and medium-term international economic cooperation in the Arctic and northern territories;
- Values of infrastructural arrangement of the regions of the North and the Arctic in the era of artificial intelligence and total “internetization”;
- Second Industrial Revolution / Industry 4.0 in the new corporate development of the North and Arctic;
- Climate change: economic, social, political and environmental consequences in the global Arctic;
- Social, demographic and ethnic problems of the territories of the North and the Arctic;
- Economic, financial and migration links of the northern and arctic territories with “mainland”;
- Cities of the Arctic and the North as centers of accumulation of knowledge and wealth and their changing role in the economic development of these territories 2.0
- Local economy, local communities and urban development of the isolated territories of the North and the Arctic in an era of increasing center-periphery contrasts: mechanisms for mitigating contradictions

Article formatting requirements:

The journal accepts Russian- and English-language research articles. The length of the article should be 17 – 23 typewritten pages (35 000 – 45 000 characters). Articles are accepted in *.rtf or *.docx formats. Page layout: 2.5 cm margins on all sides, single spacing, standard tab (1.27 cm), font Times New Roman 14 pt. The article should be structured; the IMRAD format is preferred:

- Introduction;
- Theory;
- Data and Methods;
- Methods or Model;
- Results;
- Conclusions or Discussion and Implication.

The article should have at least 25 sources in the list of references. Sources should be listed in alphabetical order, referenced in accordance with the APA style. Before submitting the manuscript, please check the sections [Journal policies](#) and [Formatting guidelines](#) on the website.

Submission guidelines:

Manuscripts should be submitted via online submission system. The author(s) should [register](#), select the “Economy of the Arctic and Northern Regions” section and upload the manuscript file following the instructions. Information about the author(s) should be sent in a [separate file](#).

Important dates:

Manuscript submission – September, 30, 2023.
Moderation – initial checking for the integrity, as well as its compliance with the scope of the journal and presentation requirements – October, 15, 2023.
Peer-Review Process – all manuscripts will undergo double-blind peer review; on average, the review process takes 60 days – December, 15, 2023.
Manuscript revision – January, 15, 2024.
Manuscript acceptance by the Editorial Board – February, 01, 2024.
Preparation for publication (proof-reading, translation, layout, draft approval) – May, 15, 2024.
Publication – June, 15, 2024.
